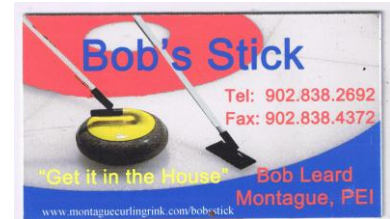

Format for Mens' pools, Round Robin with a
Championship Round

Finish order from the round robin will be determined first
by counting wins and losses for each team.

Three top teams from each pool advance to
Championship Round

Ladies pool if team undefeated through Round Robin
than Champion end place team plays 3rd place team for
runner up position: otherwise 1st plays 2nd for
Championship

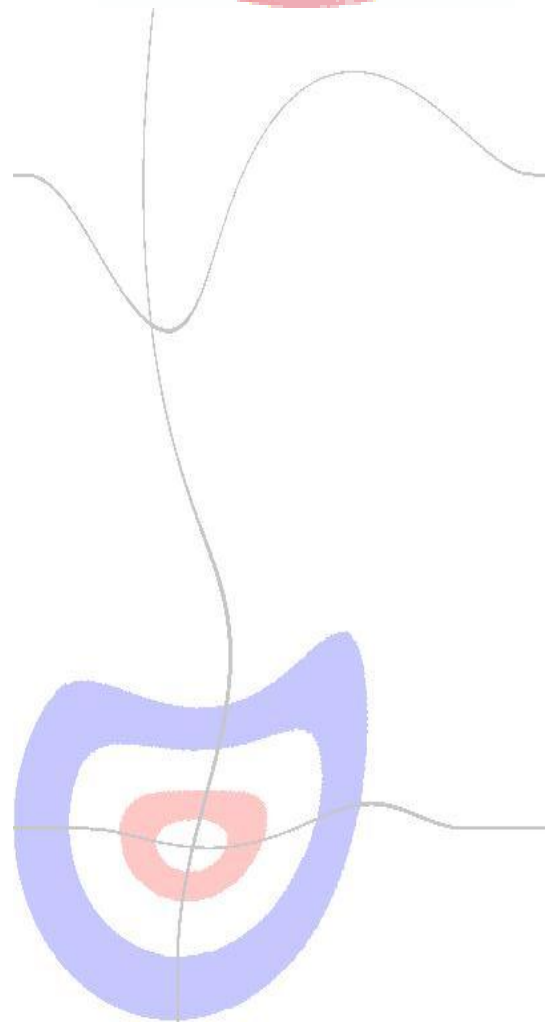
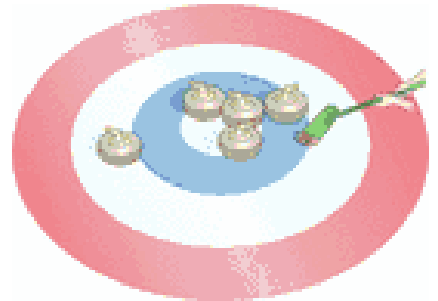
If there is a tie during the Round Robin games, then they
will play an extra end for the win. (Teams play a full extra
end with each player throwing 3 rocks.)

If teams are tied for any position by win/loss in their pool
then: higher placement to team that won head to head, if
unable to decide position than points used. Points are
awarded for each game, to be used in tie resolution.

Practice – team coin toss for rock colour – three rock
practice, last rock from away to tee line for hammer –
teams throw to their rock colour side of house for
counting.

Rock counting area measures from hog line to back line –
short or over back line DQed.

If unable to measure or neither rock qualified, than
winner of flip has choice of hammer or not.
